
General Info

- Welcome to the 2025 Men's Club at Meadow Hills. Meadow Hills Golf Course, located at the corner of East Hampden Avenue and Dawson Street in Aurora, has the look and feel of an old-style country club. Its signature tree-lined fairways, large lakes, small greens, and lush grounds, define traditional golf at its best.
- The 2025 schedule includes 10 club tournaments from April to September. These tournaments feature a variety of team and individual formats including two and four-man scrambles, two and four-man best balls, match play (season-long), individual low gross and low net stroke play, and the two-day Club Championship. Back for the 22nd year is a two-day, two-man "6-6-6" tournament (see description below). The first day will be at Murphy Creek and the second day will be played at Meadow Hills.
- *Our* popular Monday Night League will begin on April 7th, with 24 dates, finishing September 22nd. As in the past, we will have low gross and low net skins games as well as various other side games.
- The membership fee for 2025 is \$300. Membership includes USGA Handicap and CGA membership, prize money for all tournaments and entry into the Hole-in-One pot. The Hole-in-One pot is \$5.00 x the number of 2025 members. Should any member make a Hole-in-One while playing in a weekend event or during Monday Night League play, they will win the entire pot. If more than one Hole-in-One is made during the year, the pot will be split equally. Payment will be made after the last Tournament date.
- Night League event. If you had a handicap before they can compete in any tournament or Monday Night League event. If you had a handicap in 2024 at Meadow Hills or at any other golf course in the U.S., it would automatically transfer to the Meadow Hill's handicap system. If you do not have a handicap, you can establish one by entering a minimum of five 18-hole scores in the GHIN app. If you enter any tournament or Monday Night League event and you have not established a handicap, you must play at zero handicap. However, you must have an established handicap to play in the Match Play tournament.







2025 Monday Night and Tournament Schedule


- You can access the full 2025 schedule from the Meadow Hills Men's Club under the Tournament Info tab – 2025 Tournament Calendar

- Results will be linked on the calendar after each event.


Handicap Index (GHIN)


- Golfers are responsible to record all scores outside of club events in order to maintain an accurate handicap.
- Club rounds (Monday Night and Tournaments) will be added into the app by the club. YOU DO NOT NEED TO ENTER YOUR OWN SCORES FOR CLUB ROUNDS.
- Sandbagging will be called out and your handicap will be manually adjusted.






Handicap Index (GHIN)

Entering Scores


- The best way to enter scores is Hole-By-Hole.
- Do not enter your total score unless you know how to calculate your Adjusted Gross Score.
- Hole-By-Hole adjusts your gross scores automatically which is based on your maximum number of strokes allowed on a specific hole based on your course handicap.




Handicap Index (GHIN)

Golfer Lookup & Handicap Calculator


- Keep track of your friends' handicap under Golfer Lookup
- Handicap Calculator allows you to figure out your playing handicap on a specific course based on the course's Slope and Course Rating.
- Compare your playing handicap to your opponents to determine the number of strokes given or received for each player.






Monday Night League

- League play times are between 1:00 and 5:18/6:12 Monday afternoons (Latest time is based on daylight). Space is reserved for members only.
- You should have received an email with instructions on creating an account with the Men's Club Portal. You will need to log-in using your email and password before making tee times.
- Monday Night tee time registration opens the previou Friday at noon.
- Once you are in the system, you can make a reservation for 1-4 players (ONLY ONE (1) FOURSOME RESERVATION PER MEMBER). And you cannot play by yourself.
- Once you select a specific tee time, the system will hold that tee time for you while you register the other members in your group. If you don't have a full foursome, you can select any tee time that isn't full.
- Each player that is named in the reservation will get a confirmation email with the time and date of the reservation once the reservation is submitted.
- Day of registrations, please call Proshop to check on availability and last-minute dropouts. Please email your scorecard to <u>info@meadowhillsmc.com</u> following the round.
- Any player signed up on the starters list is responsible for the time even if someone else has submitted your name. If you cannot play, you must cancel before 6:00 PM on Sunday on the website. You must call the proshop to cancel after 6pm on Sunday. Each member will have one "free" no show without being held accountable. If a player misses a second time, he will not be allowed to play on Monday Nights until the greens fees for the missed times are reimbursed.
- Normal greens fees plus the MANDATORY \$5 throw in for low gross/low net will be collected at the pro shop when you show up that Monday.






MNL - Front 9: Gross and Net Skins - Blue Tees (Mon, April 5)





- You will be directed to a shopping cart powered by Square. You must select which Skins you want to pay for.
- Once you select one of the options, only pay for Qty 1










Tournament Procedures

- **Each** tournament, other than Match Play, will be limited to the first 140 entries. A waiting list is established for late entries. For flighted tournaments, entrants on the waiting list will be accepted as space in their flight becomes available.
- You must sign-up for a tournament by 6:00 PM the Tuesday prior to the event. Late entries will not be accepted.
- You must purchase your greens fee online when you signup.
- No telephone entries will be accepted. DO NOT CALL THE GOLF SHOP, THEY CANNOT ENTER YOU IN AN EVENT.
- Entries for the following tournament will be opened at the conclusion of each event.
- *Tee* times and pairings are available after 12:00p the Thursday prior to the tournament on the website at www.meadowhillsmc.com
- Results will be posted on the website within 48-72 hours of the completion of the tournament.
- The Men's Club Committee will post scores for all tournaments and Monday Night play.

 Do not post your own tournament or MNL scores on the GHIN app.
- In addition to prizes for each event, an optional skins game will be played for every event. (Prizes Explained)
- Each tournament will award a prize for closest-to-the-pin on all parthrees, the longest putt on a specified hole, and closest-to-the-pin on your second shot on a specified par four.
- Prize money: In accordance with the USGA rules of Amateur Status, all prize money for tournament play will be paid as credit to be redeemed for merchandise at any City of Aurora Golf Shop. Your GHIN number is your account number. Unused credit will remain on your account from one year to the next.
- You can signup for a tournament a couple of different ways.

Meadow Hills Men's Club Weekend Tournament Sign Up

- You will receive an email approximately 2 weeks before an event with links to sign up. The email will include the tournament date and time, format and rules.
- If you are planning on participating in the tournament, you will click on the "Playing" button at the bottom of the email which will direct you to the registration form.
- TIP: Save these emails for the future if you are unsure if you want to signup or not, it will be helpful come decision time.
- Tournament registration will also be available on the main website approximately two weeks in advance of each event.
- IMPORTANT: Members dropping out day of the tournament WILL BE responsible for their green fees for that round and will be suspended from signing up for further tournaments until that obligation is met.

Format and Rules

This format is a 36-hole stroke play event. All flights will be played at gross except for the last flight which will be played at net using 100% of the player's current handicap. Sunday's pairings will be based upon Saturday's scores, and all players will continue within their flights

In the event of a first place tie within a flight, a sudden death playoff will begin immediately starting on hole #1.

A daily skins game will be played

Order of play for this event will be Day One CH,1,2,3,4,5/Day Two 5,4,3,2,1,CH

Each player will receive another player's card to keep score in the group. At the end of the round, the player and marker must both sign the card and turn into the green box. Any card that is not signed and turned in, the player will be disqualified from the tournament.

We require one person to keep score on the Golf Genius app.

Pace Of Play Cards - There will be three checkpoints where the TIME CARD in the group will need to be timestamped. 1st tee, after the 9th hole and after the 18th hole. Players will need to stamp their own group card on 9 and 18. (Nobody will be sitting there) We will have the machine set up by the bathrooms or under the awning if bad weather. Do not punch until all players have completed the hole. Any card turned in without three-time stamps, the group will receive a 2-stroke penalty assessed on hole 18. We require you to play the front in under 2 hours and 10 minutes and complete the full round under 4 hours and 20 minutes. Any group over those times will be subject to a penalty. Please drop card in green box out side the bar after the round.

6:30 -7:00 Champ Flight 4.9 or under - Orange tees First Flight 5.0- 7.5 - Blue Tees

8:00 - 8.50 Second Flight 7.6 - 10.9 - Blue Tees

9:00 - 9:40 Third Flight 11 - 14.9 - Blue Tees

9:50 - 10:40 Fourth Flight 15 - 18.9 - Blue Tees

10:50 - 11:40 Fifth Flight 19 - 36 - Blue/White Combo Tees

Please avoid any changes (cancellations, etc.) at this point, a lot of work is going into making this thing run smoothly and changes tend to foul that up. Anybody that cancels from here on will not receive a refund.




- Every player will be emailed a unique GGID on the Thursday prior to each tournament.
- The GGID is unique to your group and is used to keep live scoring during a tournament. Only ONE player per group needs to keep score.
- The score keeper from each group must download the app GOLF GENIUS or USGA Tournament Management (they're the same) on their smart phone.






- The score keeper will log-in to one of the above apps using the GGID that was emailed with your tee time.
- Once you are logged in, you will enter the GROSS score of each player after each hole.
- Another player in the group will keep score on the paper scorecard to compare at the end.
- Keep track of how others in the tournament are doing by checking the leaderboard.





Meadow Hills Men's Club Tournament Results

- Results can be accessed on the main website under the RESULTS tab and selecting the tournament or MNL from the drop-down menu.
- Results will be updated live during tournaments.
- Prize money and proxies are typically calculated and updated the evening of the tournament.



Prize Money Payouts


- Tournament and Monday Night prize money will be added to your account at the Pro Shop.
- You can spend your prize money at the Pro Shops of any of the City of Aurora Golf Courses:
 - Meadow Hills
 - Saddle Rock
 - Murphy Creek
 - Aurora Hills
 - Springhill
- All prize money must be spent before
 December 31, 2025. Your money will not carry
 over into the new year.
- Speak to the Head Pro about ordering product that the Pro Shop does not carry.



Getting Paid Skins or Proxies via PayPal



- All payments will be made via PayPal.
- Each player is responsible for providing a cell phone number linked to a PayPal account.
- If you do not have one, you must create an account and link your cell number to that account.
- You may provide your wife or other trusted family member/friend's PayPal cell phone number if you do not want to create an account for yourself.
- To link your cell phone to your PayPal account, you must first create an account, then log-in, go to settings, and click ADD NEW under Phone Numbers.



MHMC Match Play

- All members are encouraged to play in the MHMC Match Play tournament and will receive an opt in/out email in late-May. Tournament fee for this is INCLUDED in your annual dues. Brackets & schedule will be posted by 06/05.
- Matchplay is scheduled and coordinated on your own time. Make sure you have time to play prior to signing up for multiple matchplay tournaments.
- This year's tournament brackets will be flighted based on participants 12-month low index at the start of the tournament and will be played as a net competition. Additional details about the revised match play will come later.
- The winner of each flight will receive the option for free membership to MHMC in 2025. Pro-shop credit is available instead and will be awarded to the semi and finalists.

2-MAN Match Play

- This is a pick your partner, full handicap, double elimination tournament. John will send out the invitation and additional details in mid-April. Tournament fee will be approximately \$100/team, all cash payouts.
- Matchplay is scheduled and coordinated on your own time. Make sure you have time to play prior to signing up for multiple matchplay tournaments.

FORE THE FUN Match Play

- FTF is a 100% net match play event with handicaps calculated on the day of play. We will begin the FTF Match Play after the 1st round of the MHMC Match Play is completed, likely 7/8. John will send out the invitation and additional details in mid-June. Fee will be approximately \$40/player, all cash payouts.
- Matchplay is scheduled and coordinated on your own time. Make sure you have time to play prior to signing up for multiple matchplay tournaments.

Handicap and Rules

- Maximum Handicap allowed is 36 for all events.
- A Handicap and Rules committee has been established and will communicate all issues to the Board of Directors and/or members of the club.
- **The** Handicap Committee has the responsibility of making certain that a player's handicap reflects his "potential scoring ability"; in other words, a fair representation of his skills as a golfer. It's important to understand that none of us have a "right" to a handicap index.
- **The** Handicap Committee is obligated, under its USGA compliance responsibility, to manually adjust the handicap index of members where the current index does not accurately reflect their playing ability. Submitted scores are a guideline to help manage this responsibility.
- *The* Committee will reduce the handicap of a player who scores consistently better in competitions, including Monday Night League, than in informal play (section 5-2 & 8-2 USGA Handicap System). A player's handicap shall be reduced when competitive scores and other criteria support the judgment of the Men's Club Handicap Committee, that the individual's USGA index does not accurately reflect the individual's potential scoring ability. Where such discrepancies exist, the Men's Club Member will be requested to appear before the Handicap Committee before the adjustment will take place. The member will have the opportunity to explain their handicap index, their scores submitted, and appeal any disciplinary action.
- A USGA Handicap Index shall be adjusted up or down if the player does not turn in all
 acceptable scores or otherwise does not observe the spirit of the USGA Handicap System. The
 Handicap Committee shall determine the amount of adjustment.
- If a player fails to post an acceptable score as soon as practicable after completion of the round, the Handicap Committee should post the score and/or a <u>penalty score</u> and Ratings equal to the lowest <u>handicap differential</u> in the player's <u>scoring record</u>. However, if the score not returned is unusually high, the Handicap Committee should enter the score and/or a penalty score and Ratings equal to the highest differential in the player's scoring record.
- Handicap Committee is duly responsible to identify and notify those players who regularly
 violate these rules and is authorized and encouraged to withdraw the player's Handicap Index.

Pace of Play

- The Pace of Play committee (subcommittee of the Handicap and Rules committee) has been empowered by the Board of Directors and at the request of the entire membership, to ensure that all rounds of golf will be played within a reasonable time.
- The golf course at Meadow Hills has a time rating of 4 hours and 20 minute. It is the goal of the committee
 to have all foursomes play every round in 4 hours and 20 minutes or less. USGA rules govern all tournament
 play and in respect to pace of play.
- Note 1: If the player unduly delays play between holes, he is delaying the play of the next hole.
- Note 2: For the purpose of preventing slow play, the <u>Committee</u> may, in the conditions of a competition, establish pace of play guidelines including maximum periods of time allowed to complete a <u>stipulated round</u>, a hole or a <u>stroke</u>.

Meadow Hills Men's Club Pace of Play Policy

- <u>All</u> members of any group that finishes the front nine holes in <u>2hrs and 11min</u> or more and is <u>11 minutes</u> or more behind the group directly in front of them, will be accessed a one stroke penalty. If the penalized group finishes the back nine 10 minutes or less behind the group in front of them or under 4 hours and 20 minutes, the penalty will be withdrawn. If the penalized group finishes eighteen holes of play in 4 hours and 21 minutes or more and is 11 minutes or more behind the group in front of them, all members will be assessed an additional one stroke penalty. The first foursome off is expected to play the front nine in under 2 hours and the entire round in under 4 hours, thus setting a good pace of play for the day.
- <u>All</u> members of any group that finishes eighteen holes of play in <u>4hrs and 21min</u> or more and/or is <u>11</u> minutes or more behind the group directly in front of them, will be accessed a one stroke penalty.
- <u>All</u> scores are unofficial until subject to pace of play review. Any group penalized because of slow play for
 eighteen holes will have the right to have their penalty reviewed. Lost balls or balls in the water on either 17
 or 18 will be a determining factor. However, penalties assessed after nine will not be reviewed for any
 reason but can be rescinded as previously stated. Groups falling behind after nine are expected to catch the
 group in front of them by the 18th hole.
- The pace of play for all tournaments is always a concern. The Men's Club officers, tournament hosts and volunteers will make a concerted attempt to assist all members with awareness of their pace of play. Attention to and responsibility for your individual pace of play is critical so that golf and tournament participation is enjoyable for everyone. Nobody likes to feel rushed, however, waiting to play on every shot is equally unpleasant and frustrating. We encourage all players to be aware of their individual position on the golf course. You must keep up with the group in front of you. Be ready to play by thinking about your distance and club selection as you approach your ball. Play "ready golf". If another member of your group is away, but not ready to play, go ahead and play your shot. In medal play there is no penalty for playing out of turn.
